GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION: Please submit ALL of the following information; incomplete proposals will not be reviewed. Topics should pertain to social work practice with an emphasis on trauma care and should be aimed at enhancing the practitioner’s knowledge and skills in working with populations experiencing trauma in their lives. Proposed workshops should be 3 hours in length.

I. General Information:

- Proposed title of workshop
- Presenter contact information (*if more than one, please designate a lead presenter for primary contact*)
- Special notes or considerations about the delivery of your presentation (*room setup requests, A/V needs, etc.*)

II. Proposal Abstract:

- Paragraph description (*50 words or less*) describing the topic and content of the presentation. This will be printed as the workshop description in the conference brochure.
- Learning objectives (*at least one learning objective for each hour of continuing education credit*)
- Basic outline of course content for review

III. Background Information:

- Brief biography (100 words or less) of EACH presenter, to be read as an introduction to the workshop
- Resume or CV of EACH presenter (*include any expertise specific to the proposed topic*)

The deadline for submissions is February 15, 2012.
